

**SF for Democracy Membership Meeting  
June14, 2014**

Meeting called to order 7:14pm

Peter Latterman gave an analysis of the June 3 primary elections and some thoughts about the November elections. Turnout was low (30%) as is often the case in primaries when there aren't hot button issues. Latterman said that the vote for Prop. B (requiring a referendum if proposed building heights along the waterfront exceeded current limits) continued a trend in three previous elections where San Francisco voters expressed strong concern about development along the Embarcadero (at least north of the Bay Bridge).

Dave Massen presented a slide show on climate change and the work Citizen's Climate Lobby is doing to get a carbon fee (and dividend) passed in Congress. The group has 180 chapters around the country.

SF4D members gave a vote of support to the Citizen's Climate Lobby: 10-0-0.
